Mitchell St Road Upgrade and Malcolm St Bridge Project (Kalkallo)

What is the project?

The Kalkallo area to the north-east of Hume City has experienced expediential housing growth over the past 10 years, however, has pockets of land that are still underdeveloped due to poor/rural type infrastructure.

Currently Mitchell Street is a one lane rural road with vehicles passing in opposing directions required to move over onto the gravel shoulders to allow the passing of vehicles.

The Malcolm Street bridge that connects Mitchell Street north and south is a single lane bridge and because of its structure and condition has a load limit that restricts heavy type vehicles.

The proposal is to upgrade Mitchell Street to a two-lane urban road standard and construct a new two-lane bridge that allows trucks to access and will improve overall access to current, underdeveloped new housing sites.

Why is it important to the Hume City community?

The Malcolm Street bridge that connects Mitchell Street north and south is a single lane bridge and because of its structure and condition has a load limit that restricts heavy type vehicles.

Our residents need Mitchell Street to be upgraded to a two-lane urban road standard and the construction a new two-lane bridge that will allow truck access.

It will enable further housing developments within the Kalkallo area, with the advantage of creating improved linkages to facilities such as local Primary Schools, sports reserves and community centres.

What we're seeking:

We need \$3,650,000 from the Federal Government to complete this project.
