EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Students will be awarded their scholarship at a presentation ceremony to celebrate their achievements.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for an Education Scholarship, students must:

- · Be a resident of Hume City
- Attend a primary school within Hume City at the time of nomination
- Commence secondary education in 2025

NOMINATION PROCESS

Each primary school will be asked to nominate a Year Six student for a Scholarship. Nominations must be made according to the assessment criteria below.

One recommendation per school can be submitted.

Principals are asked to coordinate the assessment and involve Year Six and relevant support teachers.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Primary schools are asked to nominate a student according to the following selection criteria. Students must:

- 1. Actively participates in their school community
- 2. Demonstrates a commitment to their own learning and development
- 3. Requires support in the transition from primary to secondary school
