Up-cycled Sock puppets

You will need:

- 1. Old Socks or old wooden spoon or paper bags.
- Craft items and materials (Can be anything from paper, ribbons, cupcake papers, old jewellery or wool).
- 3. Craft glue
- 4. Scissors
- 5. Textures



Instructions:

- 1. Children may need help to create these fun puppets.
- 2. Collect items around the house.
- 3. Have fun making cutting different shapes together to create crazy hair and facial expressions.
- 4. Share ideas and problem solve through any challenges.
- 5. Once the puppets dry create stories and rhymes together. As simple as Jack and Jill or the three little pigs.

The benefits of this activity

By engaged reading, interpreting, appreciating, evaluating and creating literature enable children to expand their ideas, think deeply and notice new things in their world. We increase our vocabulary, make connections to our emotions and collaborate within group environments.
