



PROPOSED REALIGNMENT – MICKLEHAM / CRAIGIEBURN SUBURB BOUNDARY

Hume City Council (Council) has identified a number of properties affected by an incorrect boundary alignment through the middle of 12 land parcels located on Malta Road and Gustave Avenue in Craigieburn and Mickleham.

At its meeting of 13 September 2021, Council endorsed the commencement of community consultation process seeking views of the community on realigning this part of the locality boundary between Craigieburn and Mickleham. A Suburb Boundary Realignment Plan has been included with this letter, which identifies the existing boundary, and highlights the proposed new boundary.

This proposed suburb boundary realignment, if ultimately approved, would not cause any existing property addresses to change. It only proposes to realign the locality boundary from the middle to the back boundary of the 12 land parcels.

Further information on this proposed realignment is detailed in Council Report GE552, which can be found on Council's website under *Agendas, Minutes and Audio Recordings*, for the meeting held on 13 September 2021.

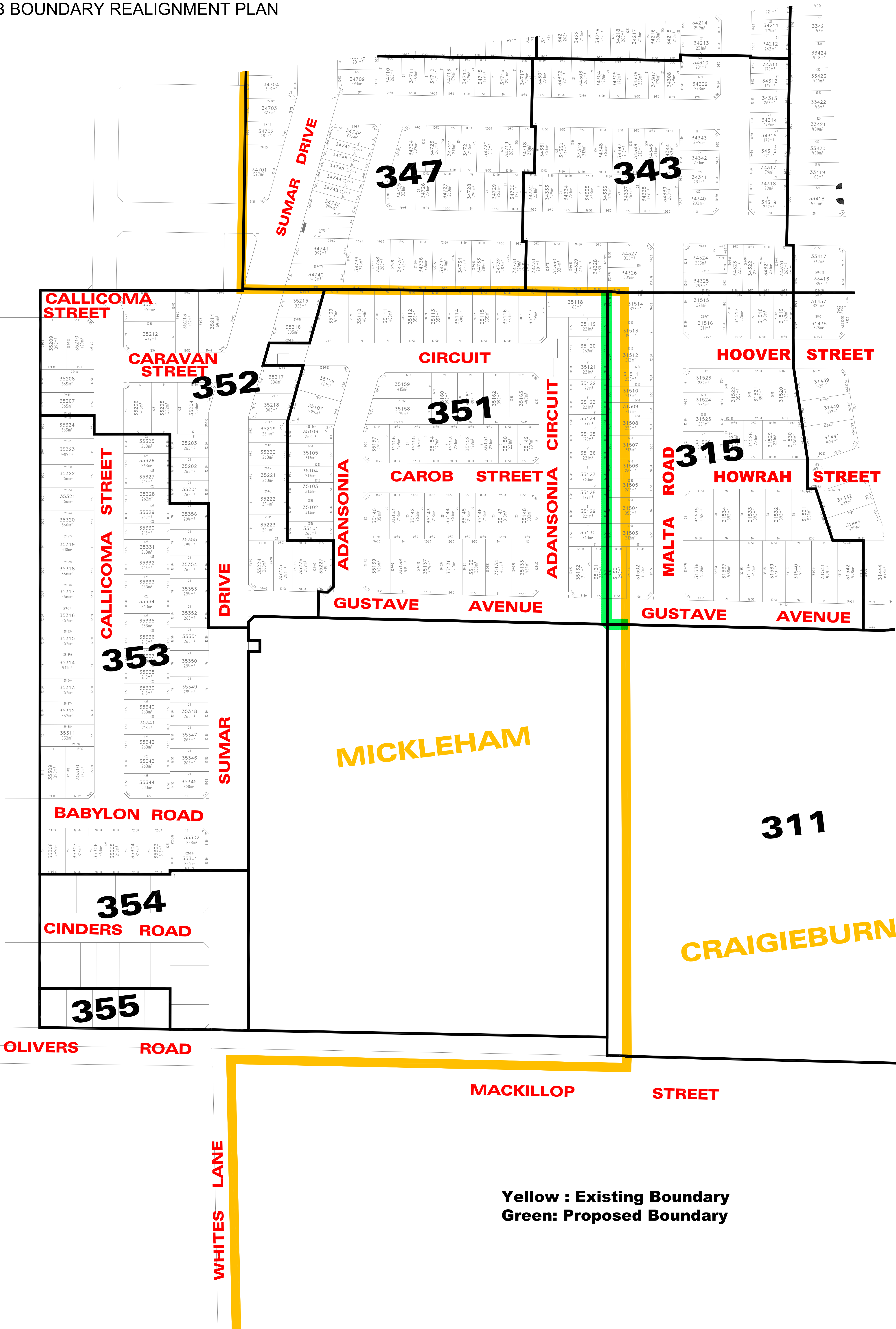
